## SAM DONALDSON HOSTS BONE MARROW FOUNDATION GALA

Brandon was a trustee of The Bone Marrow Foundation before he lost his battle to cancer in 1997. Pearce, Chairman of Hughes Electronics Corporation and the General Motors Cancer Research Foundation. Mr. Pearce, himself a bone marrow transplant recipient and leukemia survivor, has long been a dedicated advocate of cancer-related causes.
